Papercloth: Tuny Jennings

Learn the technique of making papercloth, to create materials you can incorporate in collage, cards, jewelry or anywhere a touch of rich texture will enhance your work. Or use it by itself!

Learn the Basics: Types of paint to use; additions to the paint, and basic techniques. This is a fun painting technique that everyone can do. Bring an apron or cover-up as we can become quite creative!

Working from a Thought Sketch to a Finished Piece: Rick Otoupalik

Participants will start with a piece of sketch paper and a Prismacolor Ebony pencil. They will sketch 4 to 6 ideas, then pick one of them and use that sketch to make a more detailed sketch. Then lightly sketch their chosen thumbnail on watercolor paper and execute it with black and red oriental ink. From a thought to a finished product in about three steps!
