2. **PICK A COLOR:** Choose any color and make sure at least 75% of your artwork features that color.
3. **SHOE ART:** Create a 2-D or 3-D piece featuring shoes. You may decorate an actual shoe or create an artwork that depicts one.
4. **TEXTURES GALORE:** Use a variety of materials to create a richly textured piece of art.

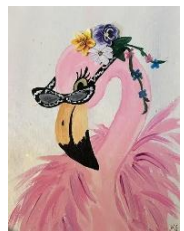
MONDAY, NOV. 9

Art Book Making: Kathleen Simpson

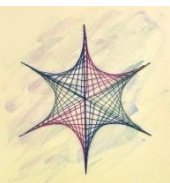
Painting on paper along with cutting and folding paper leads to constructing your own unique art book. It's that easy!

Drawing: Kim Urr

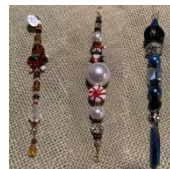
Drawing is a skill you can learn. I will teach you how to see shapes, light and shadow to make a finished drawing.
